Before joining Ogilvy Government Relations, Jen was the head of government affairs and Chief of Staff at Indigov, a government technology startup. At Indigov she dramatically increased sales to government entities and spearheaded strategy with political stakeholders.

Jen holds a law degree from Southern Illinois University, where she served as president of the Student Bar Association, and a bachelor's degree in political science from Eastern Illinois University where she was a collegiate athlete. She was recently awarded the Stennis Center for Public Service's Cresswell Award for the 117th Congress by her former Congressional colleagues.
