SUBJECT: October 5-8 Survey of Nebraska Likely Voters

Torchlight Strategies conducted a statewide survey of likely Nebraska voters for the Fischer campaign from October 5-8, 2024.

Democrat dark money groups have poured millions of dollars into the Nebraska Senate race in hopes of holding their majority, but Senator Fischer's advertising has clearly been effective. Senator Fischer has a lead in the election outside of the margin of error and that margin will grow as voters learn more about Dan Osborn's extreme views and ties to radical Democrats.

The election for US Senate in Nebraska currently stands at:

Deb Fischer 48%
Dan Osborn 42%
Undecided/Not Sure 10%

Unsurprisingly, Donald Trump has a commanding 57%-37% lead statewide over Kamala Harris. As voters learn about President Trump's endorsement of Senator Fischer, her vote share will grow.

Additionally, nearly a third of voters have not yet realized that Dan Osborn is a Democrat pretending to be an Independent. When voters learn the truth about Osborn's radical left ideology and the Democrat dark money that is funding him, they move toward Senator Fischer.

With proper funding Senator Fischer will be able to tell her story, making it from a cattle ranch to the US Senate and fighting for Nebraska's conservative values. That, coupled with educating voters about Dan Osborn's radical leftist ideology, will put this race to bed.

Methodology – The survey was conducted from October 5-8, 2024. We surveyed 600 voters with a mix of 331 live calls and 269 text to web surveys. The margin of error on the survey at a 95% confidence level is +/-4.0%. Results were slightly weighted to ensure proper balance by age, gender, 2020 vote recall, and congressional district to ensure balance.
