The House has 11 legislative days left before the fiscal year ends; the Senate has 15.

For the good of our country, the Executive Council of the Problem Solvers Caucus urges House and Senate leadership to put differences aside and sit down together in the spirit of bipartisanship every single day until a solution is reached.
