

“A subpoena is a powerful, coercive tool that must be used carefully and in pursuit of legitimate oversight instead of political retribution. The practice of providing 48-hour notice before issuing a subpoena allowed the minority party to raise timely concerns and suggest modifications to prevent abuses and mistakes, less intrusive ways to secure the same information, or even to offer support. Chairman Comer’s inexplicable decision to abandon this long-standing practice, which had been observed for the past two Congresses, flies in the face of his stated goal of transparency and undermines any claim that he has been operating in good faith.”
