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Methodology



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Public Opinion Survey

- N=135 respondents
- Survey of Capitol Hill chiefs of staff, legislative directors, communications directors, press secretaries, and staff directors
- Conducted online by LSG September 9-27, 2024

Summary of Key Findings



Capitol Hill senior staffers believe taxes, inflation, and immigration will be the TOP priorities for the next Congress to address.



Most – including 55% of Republican senior staffers – believe the Democratic Party has more momentum heading in the November general election.



Most believe Kamala HARRIS will win the 2024 election. Senior staffers are SPLIT by party on who will win PA, GA, and AZ – while majorities in both parties believe Harris will win WI, MI, and NV.



Most Dem. senior staffers believe the Harris/Walz ticket will **HELP** Democrats down ballot, while nearly half of GOP senior staffers believe the Trump/Vance ticket will **HARM** Republicans down ballot.



Most believe Democrats will win the Senate races in AZ, PA, MI, NV, and WI, while split by party on who will win in MD and OH. Most believe Republicans will win the Senate races in MT, TX, and FL.

Legislative Issues

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Senior staffers believe it is UNLIKELY that there will be a government shutdown before the end of the year






