## New Dem Leadership Endorses Abigail Spanberger for Battleground Leadership Representative

Washington, D.C. – Today, New Democrat Coalition Leadership Members endorsed Rep. Abigail Spanberger (VA-07) to serve as the Battleground Leadership Representative. New Dem Chair Suzan DelBene (WA-01) released the below statement on the endorsement:

"Our leadership team endorsed New Dem Rep. Susie Lee's (NV-03) proposal to create a Battleground Leadership Representative as part of the Democratic Leadership team.
