## **EMILYs List Puts Juan Ciscomani "On Notice"**

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Today EMILYs List, the nation's largest resource for women in politics, announced that it was placing Rep. Juan Ciscomani (AZ-06) "On Notice." Ciscomani joins 22 other extremist anti-choice House Republicans as some of EMILYs List's top targets to defeat in the 2024 election cycle. EMILYs List President Laphonza Butler released the following statement:

"Rep. Juan Ciscomani is vastly out of touch with Arizonans and with most Americans. Most Arizonans opposed overturning *Roe v. Wade*, but Ciscomani 'applauded' it, and he supported Arizona's extreme abortion ban that contained no exceptions for rape or incest and that could even result in doctors being prosecuted. Ciscomani has consistently caved to Republican extremism and acted against his constituents' best interest in office, and his time is up."

EMILYs List, the nation's largest resource for women in politics, works to elect Democratic pro-choice women up and down the ballot and across the country with a goal of fighting for our rights and our communities. Our work is centered around a fundamental vision: Run. Win. Change the World. EMILYs List has raised \$850 million in service to that vision and has helped Democratic women win competitive elections by recruiting and training candidates, supporting and helping build strong campaigns, researching the issues that impact women and families, running one of the largest independent expenditure operations for Democrats, and turning out women voters to the polls.
