Subject: Turek Continues to Hold Commanding Lead Over Wahls in Iowa Democratic Primary Election

Date: May 21, 2026

PPP's newest Iowa Democratic Senate poll finds Josh Turek continuing to hold a commanding lead over Zach Wahls, 52-31.

Turek's message and profile are proving to have a great deal of appeal to primary voters. 68% rate him favorably to only 6% with a negative view of him.

Wahls is broadly well liked too, with 60% of primary voters holding a positive opinion of him to just 10% with an unfavorable one. But voters who like both of the Democratic hopefuls like Turek better. He's up 56-33 with that group of voters.

Turek has an especially commanding lead (65-29) among those who have already returned their ballots. And he's particularly strong with seniors, leading 61-23.

After trailing in our early polling Turek took a substantial lead in April as voters became more familiar with him, and with less than two weeks to go there's not much evidence of that advantage receding.

PPP surveyed 672 likely Democratic primary voters on behalf of Vote Vets on May 20th and 21st. The survey's margin of error is +/-3.8%.
