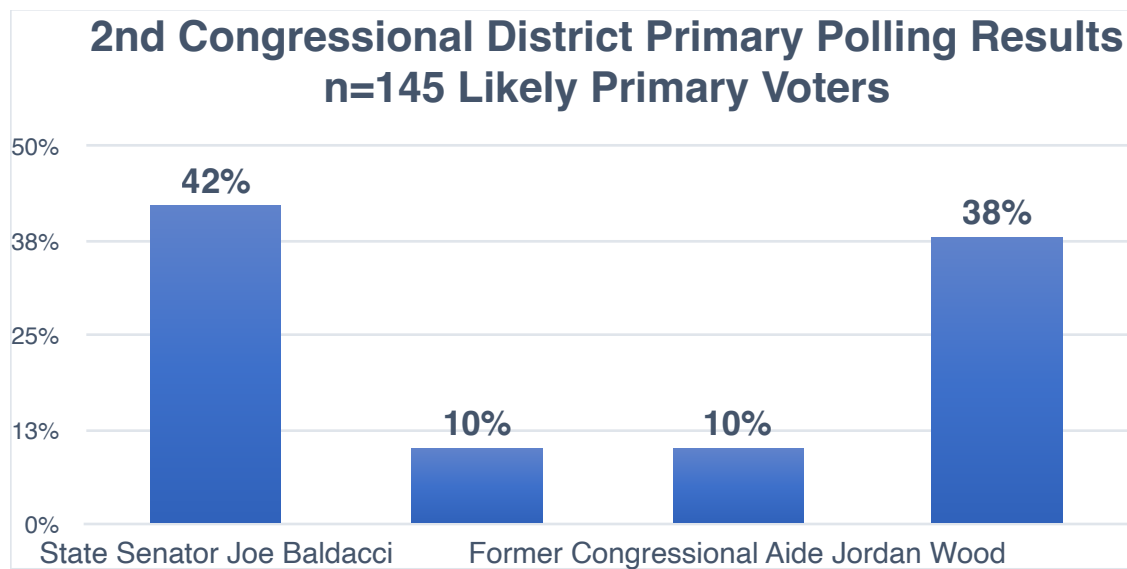


MAINE POLLING MEMO – U.S. REPRESENTATIVE ELECTION, 2ND CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT

The following represents data collected by Pan Atlantic Research on behalf of Joe Baldacci as part of its 67th Omnibus Poll. The margin of sampling error for primary election polling results is ± 8.4 percentage points, while the margin of sampling error for the general election polling results is ± 5.1 percentage points.

2ND CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT PRIMARY POLLING RESULTS

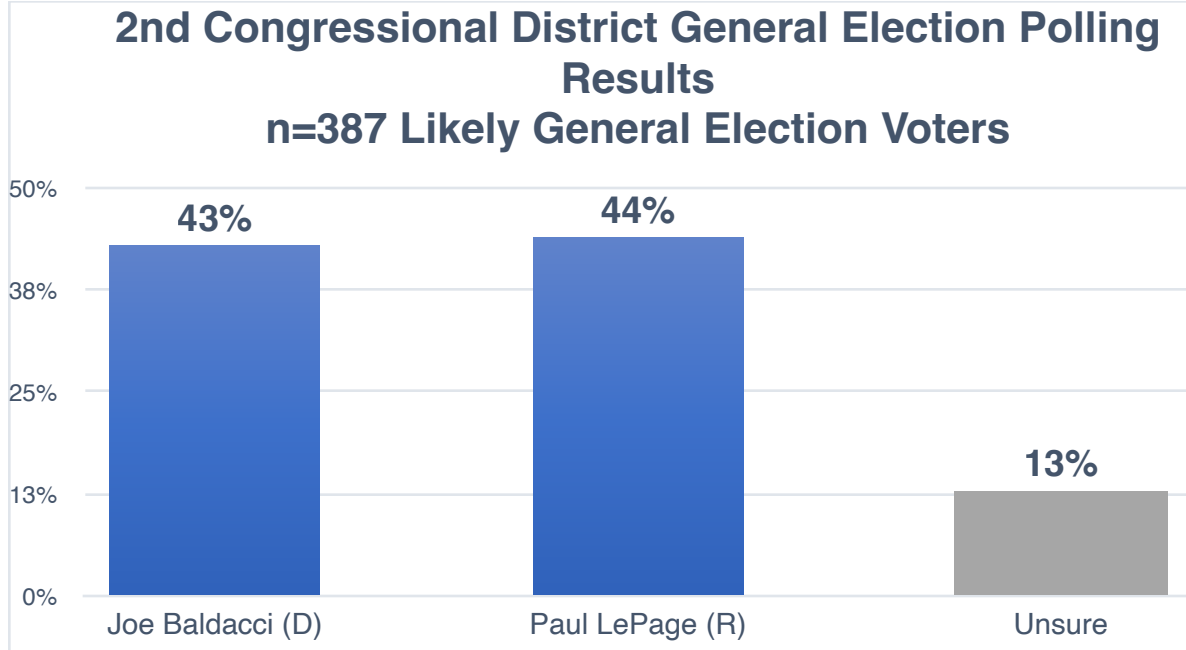
Likely primary voters in the 2nd Congressional District were asked who they would vote for if the Democratic Congressional primary were held today. **When presented with three possible candidates for the Democratic nomination for U.S. Congress in the 2nd district, a plurality of respondents (42%) named State Senator Joe Baldacci as their preferred candidate.** 10% named each of State Senator Matt Dunlapp and Former Congressional Aide Jordan Wood.

2ND CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT GENERAL ELECTION POLLING RESULTS

Likely voters in the 2nd Congressional District general election were asked who they would vote for if the election were held today between Democrat Joe Baldacci and Republican Paul LePage. **When presented with a potential Baldacci-LePage matchup in the 2nd district, 44% of respondents stated that they would vote for Paul LePage and 43% named Joe Baldacci**, well within the margin of error of ± 5.1 percentage points. 13% of respondents were unsure of their preference in this potential matchup.

387 Maine 2nd Congressional District likely general election voters; 145 Maine 2nd Congressional District likely primary voters. Fielded from 11/29/2025 through 12/7/2025. Fielded using the Dynata web panel marketplace and weighted to represent likely Maine voters based on education, gender, and age by Pan Atlantic Research, a leading Maine-based market research firm, as part of their 67th Omnibus Poll.
