"We call on the Biden-Harris Administration to end its counter-productive calls for a ceasefire and its ongoing diplomatic pressure campaign against Israel. Nasrallah's death is a major step forward for the Middle East, and today's victory for peace and security should be used to reassert America's ironclad support for Israel as it fights for its very right to exist."
