RE: **Available Security Resources**

Yesterday's attack against Mr. Paul Pelosi, Speaker Pelosi's husband, is a somber reminder of the threats elected officials and families face in 2022.

Our hearts are with all of you and your families during this time.

The United States Capitol Police (USCP) has a dedicated team of investigators who are working closely with the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the San Francisco Police Department on this case. Prosecutors will be providing more details when they can.

Meanwhile, across the country, the USCP Threat Assessment Section is working around the clock to stop thousands of potential threats in their tracks.

Despite that work, it is critical that we urge you all to take advantage of additional USCP resources that could help protect you and your families:

- Residential Security Assessments – Evaluating your residences to recommend the best security system for your home
- Law Enforcement Coordination – Working with your staff and local law enforcement to provide security coverage to protect you and your loved ones at public events
- Security Awareness Briefings – Training you and your staff on what to do if you receive a threat and what to do in an emergency
- Directed patrols of local and in district residence – Ensure police drive by your homes with greater frequency to make sure you and your loved ones are secure
