

What we're watching

Monday: The House Rules Committee will <u>meet</u> to set the floor schedule for H.R. 1, the House GOP's energy package.

Tuesday: The Senate Armed Services Committee will <u>hear</u> from Defense Secretary **Lloyd Austin**, Joint Chiefs of Staff Chair Gen. **Mark Milley** and Undersecretary of Defense **Michael McCord**. House Appropriations will <u>hear</u> from Air Force Secretary **Frank Kendall**; Gen. **Charles Q. Brown**, **Jr.**, Air Force chief of staff, and Gen. **B. Chance Saltzman**, chief of space operations for the U.S. Space Force.

House Approps will also <u>hear</u> from Interior Secretary **Deb Haaland**, HHS Secretary <u>Xavier Becerra</u>, <u>House officials</u>, <u>CFTC officials</u>, <u>Army officials</u> and EPA Administrator <u>Michael Regan</u>. House Transportation and Infrastructure will have a <u>hearing</u> on implementation of 2022 infrastructure law. House Energy and Commerce will have a <u>hearing</u> on the Feb. 3 train derailment in East Palestine, Ohio.

House Oversight will have a <u>hearing</u> on the infant formula shortage. House Agriculture will <u>hear</u> from Agriculture Secretary **Tom Vilsack.** House Homeland Security will have a <u>hearing</u> on the northern border. House Administration will have a <u>hearing</u> on Election Day problems in Luzerne County, Pa.

House Energy and Commerce will have a <u>hearing</u> about Big Tech.

House Ways and Means will have a hearing with Becerra.

Senate Judiciary will <u>hear</u> from Homeland Security Secretary Alejandro Mayorkas. Senate Appropriations will <u>hear</u> from Carlos Del Toro, the secretary of the Navy; Adm. Michael Gilday, the chief of naval operations; and Gen. David H. Berger, the commandant of the Marine Corps. **Senate Banking** will have a <u>hearing</u> about recent bank collapses with FDIC Chair **Martin Gruenberg**, Fed Vice Chair **Michael Barr** and Undersecretary of Treasury **Nellie Liang**.

Senate Appropriations will hear from Attorney General Merrick Garland.

Wednesday: House Foreign Affairs will have a <u>hearing</u> with military inspectors general about Ukraine aid.

House Appropriations will hear from several key Biden administration figures including: <u>Garland</u>, <u>Navy and Marine Corps officials</u>, <u>officials talking about the state of rural America</u>, <u>Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen</u>, Capitol Police Chief <u>Thomas Manger</u>, FDA Commissioner <u>Robert Califf</u> and SEC Commissioner <u>Gary Gensler</u>.

House Budget will have a <u>hearing</u> on the "Fiscal State of the Union." **House Armed Services** will <u>hear from</u> Austin and Milley. **House Oversight** will <u>hear</u> from a group of D.C. officials that includes D.C. Council Chair **Phil Mendelson**.

House Energy and Commerce will have a <u>hearing</u> about NIL in college sports and another <u>hearing</u> with inspectors general on Biden administration spending.

Gruenberg, Barr and Liang will be in front of House Financial Services.

Senate Appropriations will also hear from: <u>Haaland</u>, <u>Mayorkas</u>, Veteran Affairs Secretary <u>Denis McDonough</u>, <u>Vilsack</u>,
