## What we're watching

- → Monday: The House Natural Resources subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources will hold a <u>hearing</u> in Midland, Texas, entitled "Federal Energy Production Supports Local Communities." Senate Rules will hold an <u>organizational meeting</u>.
- → Tuesday: The Senate Judiciary Committee will hold a <u>hearing</u> on "protecting our children online." Senate Commerce will have a <u>hearing</u> on the nomination of **Gigi Sohn** to be a member of the FCC.

**Senate Banking** will have a hearing on the "crypto crash" and why "why financial system safeguards are needed for digital assets." The witnesses are all academics. The Senate Foreign Affairs Committee will have a hearing on the <u>nomination</u> of **Richard Verma** to be deputy secretary of state for management and resources.

→ **Wednesday:** Senate HELP will have a <u>hearing</u> on a slew of nominations. **Fiona Hill** among others will be in front of the Senate Armed Services Committee for a <u>hearing</u> on global threats. Senate EPW will have a <u>hearing</u> on "low carbon transportation fuels."

**Senate Commerce** will have a <u>hearing</u> on the NOTAM system – the alert mechanism for pilots which has been the subject of much criticism after the FAA grounded flights last month. **Billy Nolen**, the acting FAA administrator, will testify.

**Senate Budget** will have a <u>hearing</u> on "climate related economic risks." Among those testifying: **Mark Carney**, who served as the former governor of the banks of Canada and England.

**Senate Foreign Relations** will have a <u>hearing</u> on the trafficking of fentanyl. Officials from the State Department, Justice Department and the White House are slated to testify.

**Senate Finance** will <u>consider</u> the nomination of **Daniel Werfel** to be the head of the IRS.

→ **Thursday:** Senate EPW will have a <u>hearing</u> on the impact of the war on Russia on global energy security one year after the invasion. Senate EPW will have a <u>hearing</u> on health care workforce shortages.

**Senate Agriculture** will have a <u>hearing</u> on the farm bill and nutrition programs. Two Agriculture Department officials will testify. Senate Finance will have a <u>hearing</u> on trade laws.
